

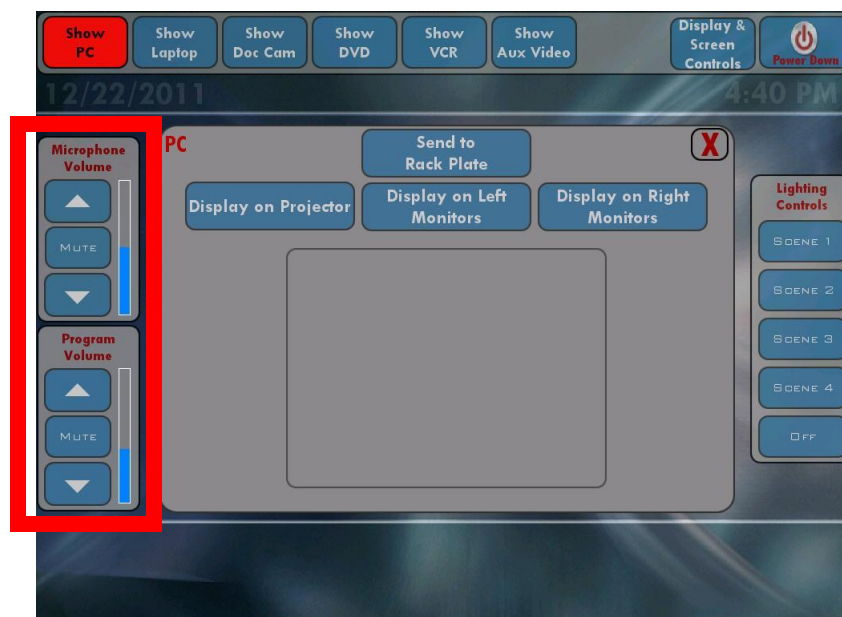


Knight 215 Technology Instructions

1. Touch the touch screen to turn system on.



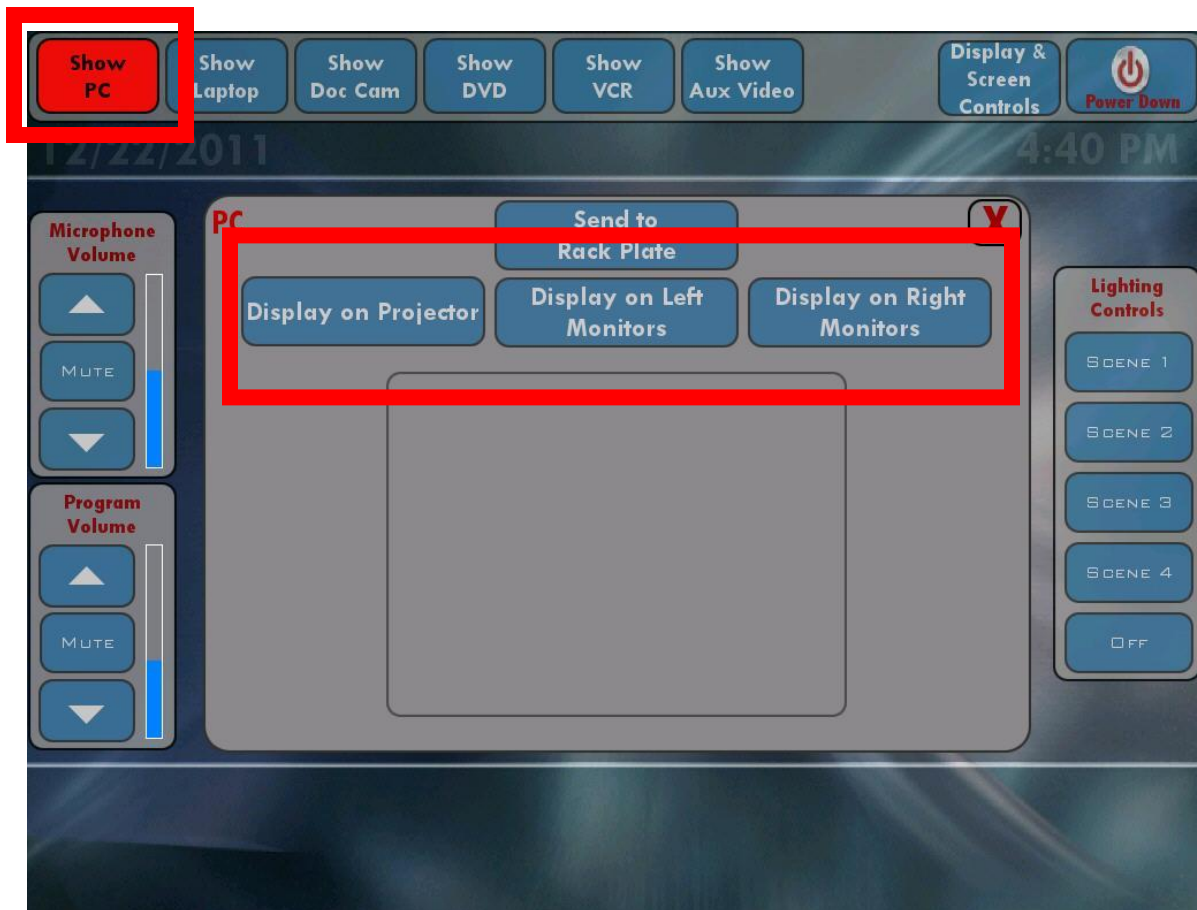
2. Select a source at the top of screen. Microphone and Program (DVD/VCR and computer) Volume controls are available on the left.





Knight 215 Technology Instructions -Show PC-

1. Select "Show PC" from top of screen
2. To display on Projector or LCD Screens press:
 - a. Display on Right Monitor
 - b. Display on Left Monitor
 - c. Display on Projector

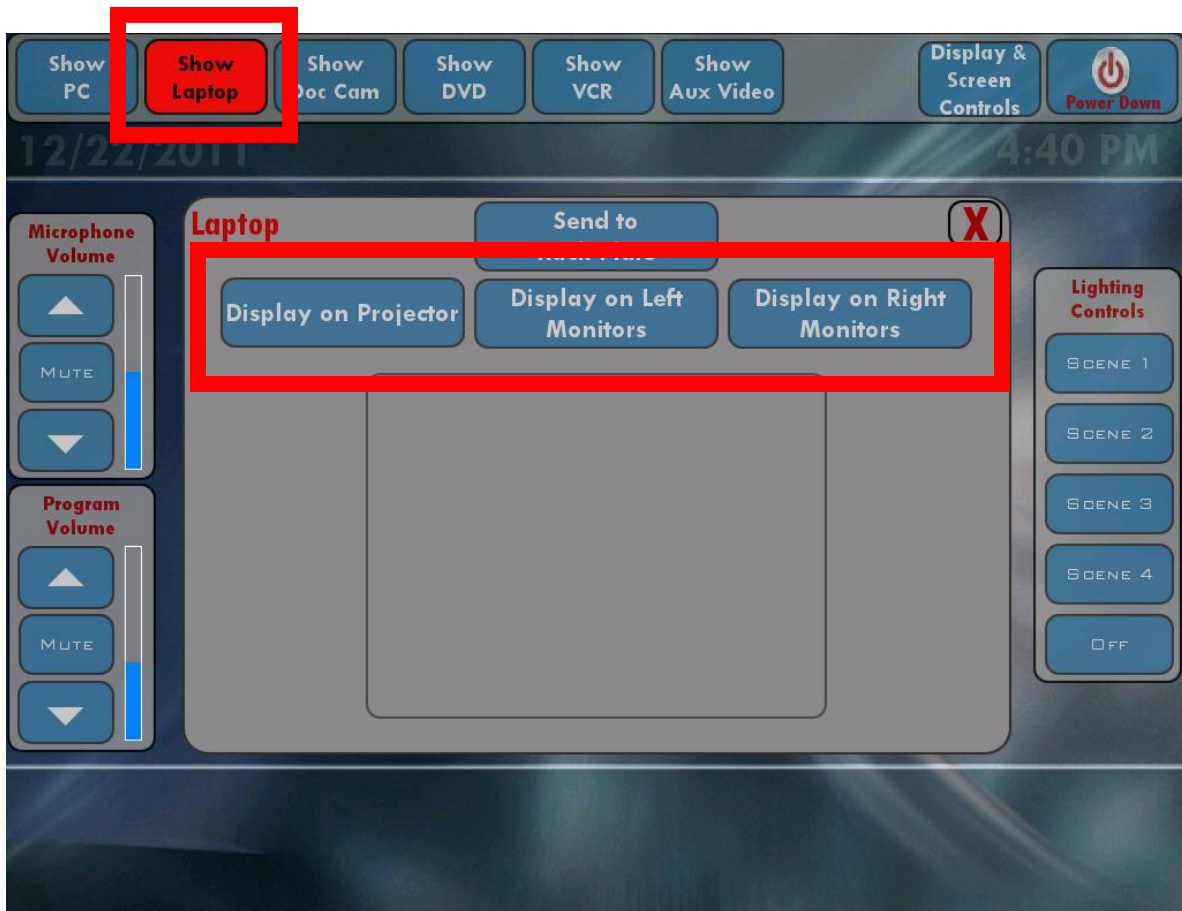


NOTE: All 3 displays can be on at same time, it is user preference

1. Select “Show Laptop” from top of screen
2. To display on Projector or LCD Screens press:
 - a. Display on Right Monitor
 - b. Display on Left Monitor
 - c. Display on Projector



NOTE: All 3 displays can be on at same time, it is user preference

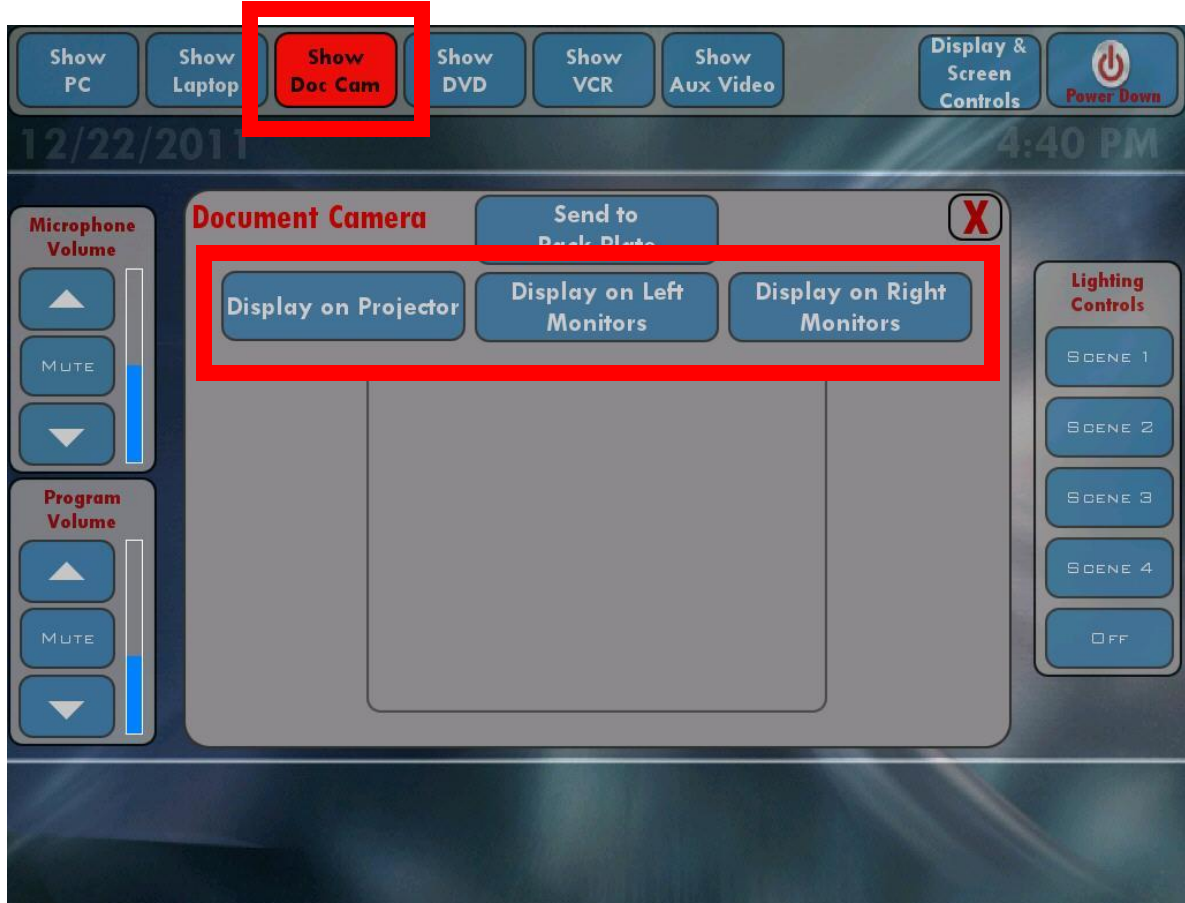

1. Select "Show Doc Cam" from top of screen.
 - a. NOTE: You must manually turn Doc Cam on using Power button located on the bottom left of the camera.
2. To display on Projector or LCD Screens press:
 - a. Display on Right Monitor
 - b. Display on Left Monitor
 - c. Display on Projector

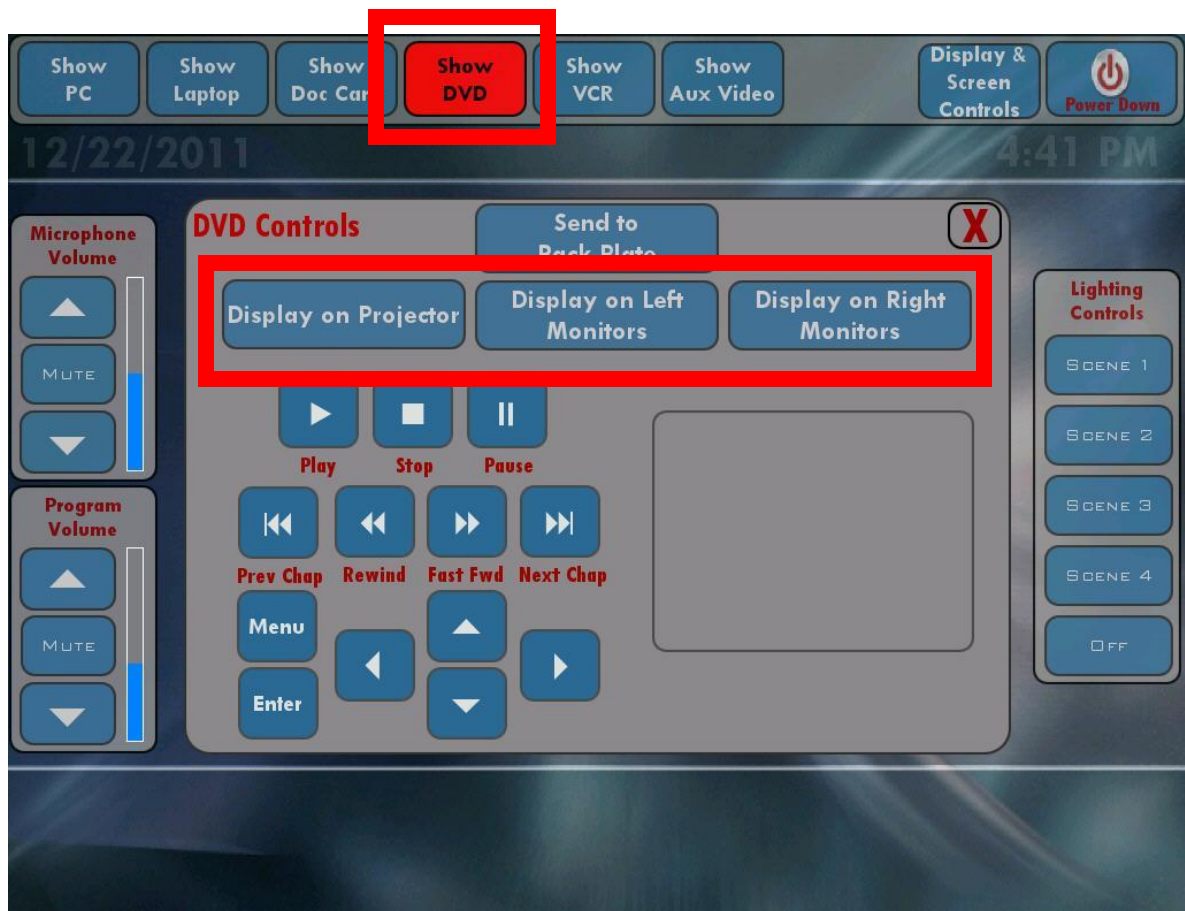


NOTE: All 3 displays can be on at same time, it is user preference

1. Select “Show DVD” from top of screen.

3. To display on Projector or LCD Screens press:

 - c. Display on Projector

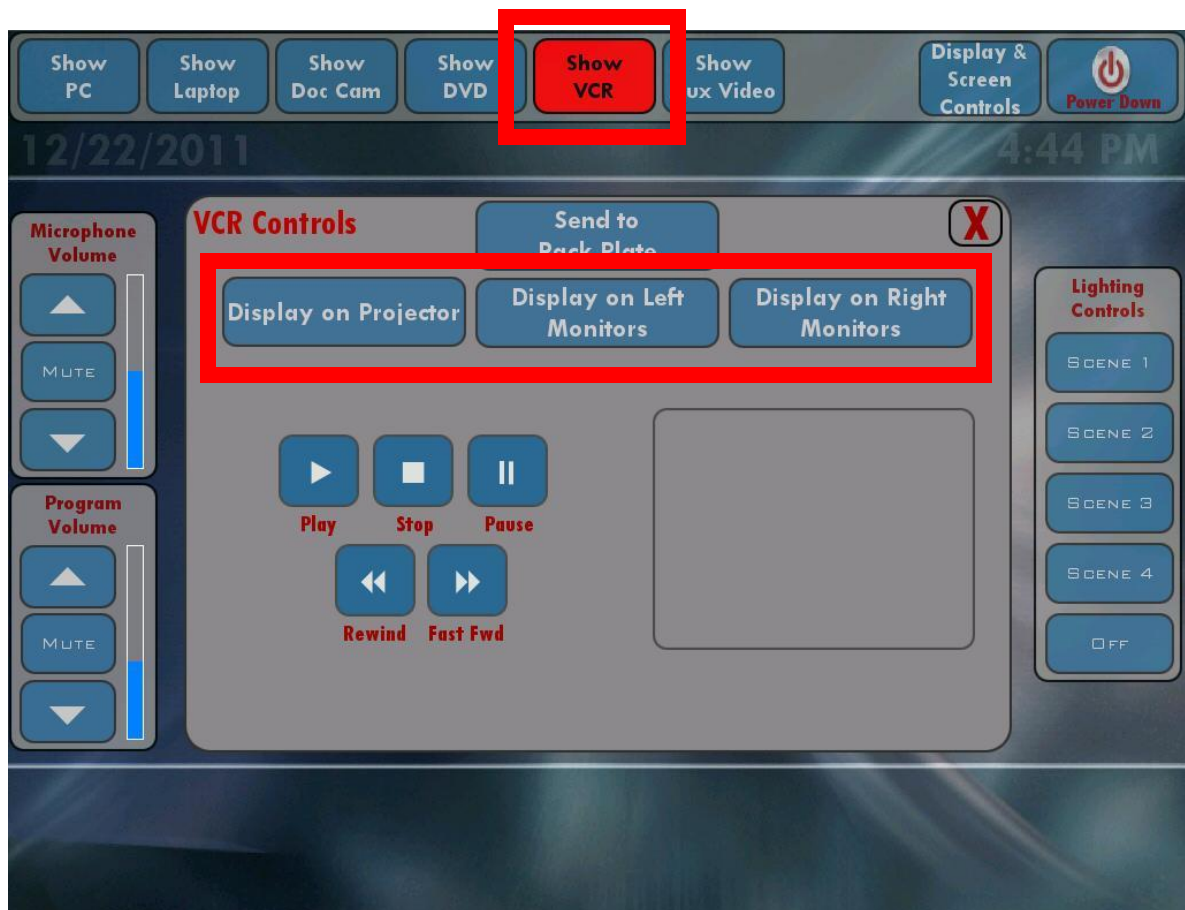


NOTE: All 3 displays can be on at same time, it is user preference
