WHERE YOUR MONEY GOES...

Through the PILG Endowment Fund at The University of Connecticut Law School Foundation, Inc., PILG is able to fund students who work in low- or non-paying internships in public interest law. Below are descriptions from some of the students who received grants for jobs they held during the summer of 2009. Thank you for your support!

Renee VandenWallBake, Center for Children's Advocacy and Office of the Child Advocate, Hartford, CT

This past summer I received a grant from PILG to split my time between the Center for Children's Advocacy, which is a direct advocacy organization for children in Hartford who need assistance in accessing special education services, child protection services, etc.; and the Office of the Child Advocate, which is a government office that oversees the child welfare system in Connecticut. At both organizations I did a lot of research and writing, including examining models of child services in other states. At the Center, I talked with parents and children, met them at various facilities and home visits, and collaborated with attorneys on in and out of court advocacy.

Jessica Feldman, Bet Tzedek Legal Services, Los Angeles, California

This past summer, with the help of the Public Interest Law Group Fellowship, I was able to work for Bet Tzedek Legal Services in Los Angeles, California. Bet Tzedek is one of Los Angeles's oldest and largest community legal service organizations. Bet Tzedek has several areas of focus, including employment and labor law, bankruptcy law, and elder law. It also runs a unique Holocaust Reparations program that reaches out to Holocaust survivors to help them prepare applications for reparations. As a summer intern, I worked in the Caregiver unit with clients with unique issues surrounding conservatorships, elder abuse, housing, and insurance. It was an amazing experience and I could not have done it without the generous support of PILG.

Kathryn Yates, Children's Law Center of Connecticut, Hartford, CT

During the summer I interned at the Children's Law Center of Connecticut in Hartford, CT. The Children's Law Center is a non-profit agency comprised of attorneys and social workers who provide representation for indigent children whose families are in 'high conflict' custody cases. It is the only agency in Connecticut that provides representation, as either a Guardian *ad litem* (GAL) or Attorney of the Minor Child, for indigent children free of charge. In our cases, the children usually need representation because the parents cannot agree about custody arrangements for the children and threatened with the possibility of losing their children, parents will fight hard, often to the detriment of their children. As an intern, I was able to participate fully and work very closely with the children, families, and the court. It is a small non-profit and so the PILG Fellowship was pivotal for me to have such a wonderful experience.

Yamuna Menon, CT Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities, Hartford, Connecticut

I was fortunate enough to receive the 2009 Public Interest Law Fellowship, and I worked at the CT Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities. The CHRO is Connecticut's administrative agency designed to enforce and protect the state's anti-discrimination statutes. It handles complaints of discrimination based on employment, public accommodation, housing and credit as well as complaints of sexual harassment. I worked in the appellate division, researching and writing appellate state and federal briefs and amicus briefs. I also mainly worked on employment discrimination cases and learned quite a lot about the CT anti-discrimination statutes. It was really interesting to work for the state government in a capacity where the agency is not necessarily defending the state, but many times is defending an individual.

Marisa Spittal, National Center for Law and Economic Justice, New York City, NY

I worked at the National Center for Law and Economic Justice, formerly the Welfare Law Center, in New York City. The National Center has been filing federal class action lawsuits on behalf of the indigent since the late 60s, and the Executive Director, Henry Freedman, was one of the original attorneys in the landmark 14th amendment procedural due process case *Goldberg v. Kelly*. Primarily, NCLEJ files class action lawsuits on behalf of people who qualify for public benefits such as Food Stamps and Medicaid – speeding up and equalizing the process for America's neediest and most deserving citizens. I was able to help draft motions for class certification in federal and state jurisdictions across the country and research complex administrative and constitutional issues. I am so grateful and honored that the PILG Grant committee chose to support me. I would not have been able to work at the National Center otherwise.

Ailla Wasstrom-Welz, Green Valley Institute, Brooklyn, CT

Because of the PILG fellowship I was able to work at the Green Valley Institute, an organization dedicated to developing and promoting land use strategies protective of environmentally sensitive areas. I drafted land use regulations for eight towns located within the Natchaug River Basin watershed. The draft regulations were specifically targeted at protecting water resources and were recommended to each of the eight towns as part of a larger Conservation Action Plan for the region.

Nicole Netkin-Collins, Legal Counsel for the Elderly, Washington, DC

This past summer I interned at AARP's Legal Counsel for the Elderly in Washington, DC. Specifically, I interned for one of their programs called, Project HELP, an acronym that stands for DC Homebound Elderly Project. Project HELP attorneys provide free civil legal services to low-income senior citizens in DC who are not able to leave their homes. I went on numerous home visits with my supervising attorney, helped draft wills and powers of attorney, conducted client interviews, observed several attorneys in court and wrote several research memos. Overall it was an enjoyable experience that would have been difficult, if not impossible, to have without being awarded the PILG Fellowship.

Ellen Messali, World Organization for Human Rights USA

Last summer, I worked for an small, impact litigation non-profit called World Organization for Human Rights USA, located in Washington, D.C. It is a unique organization in that its primary focus is on the United States' compliance with international human rights norms, using litigation as the primary tool for securing compliance. I interned for the Refugee Rights Project, which works to protect victims of female genital mutilation, human trafficking, and forced marriage. My primary assignment for the summer was to co-author a brief for submission to the Board of Immigration Appeals, arguing for asylum for one of our clients, a trafficking victim.

Jason Goodson, Equal Employment Opportunity Commission in the Office of Federal Operations, Washington, DC

This summer I was employed as a legal intern at the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission in the Office of Federal Operations. The Equal Employment Opportunity Commission is a federal agency charged with ending employment discrimination. I was placed in the Appellate Review Program which is a section of the Office of Federal Operations that adjudicates appeals of final decisions issued by agencies within the government on employment discrimination complaints filed by agency employees. This summer, I was primarily responsible for screening appellate case files, drafting appellate decisions, monitoring compliance with these decisions, and preparing legal memoranda on various Equal Employment Opportunity issues.
