Also, I understand that it is necessary to reapply each year for financial assistance.

I understand that it is my responsibility to complete a federally required student loan entrance interview online (www.law.uconn.edu/studfin) if I am receiving a Federal Stafford Loan and/or a Grad Plus Loan for the first time as a student at the University of Connecticut School of Law. I understand that my student loan will not be processed until this requirement is met.
