Some American Lawyer documents are unavailable due to licensing restrictions. <b>Coverage begins Jan./Feb/ 1995.</b></p>	<p><b>AMLAWR:</b> COVERAGE: From <b>1987 through current.</b> FREQUENCY: Monthly.
