#### SECTION 2: Type of Financial Aid

Summer financial aid will be based on your enrollment at the time your application is reviewed. You **must** enroll for the summer term **prior** to submitting your summer aid application. **THIS INCLUDES ALL EXTERNSHIPS AND SRP'S. DO YOUR PAPERWORK EARLY.** Enrollment will be verified before a student will be allowed to begin work-study employment. **Students taking a total of less than 6 credits for the entire summer may be considered for private loans and work study only.** Students entering the School of Law in the Fall 2008 are not eligible for summer financial aid funds.

**A. Please indicate the type(s) of financial aid you are applying for:**

- Federal Work-Study (The application deadline is April 16, 2008. The University mandates this deadline.)**
- Federal Stafford Loan (The priority deadline is May 1, 2008. Students are eligible **ONLY** if they have NOT utilized their total of \$20,500 during the fall and spring semesters AND are registered for a total of at least 6 summer credits.)
- Federal GRAD Plus Loan (The priority deadline is May 1, 2008. Students must be registered for at least 6 summer credits.)
- Private Loans (The priority deadline is May 1, 2008.)

**Federal Work-Study:**

- 3 credit minimum during the summer (TOTAL number of credits)

**Federal Stafford Loan:**

- **The last day to process Federal Stafford Loans will be two weeks prior to the end of the academic period.** Student must have borrowed less than a total of \$20,500 during the fall 2007 and spring 2008 semester and be registered for at least 6 summer credits.

**Federal GRAD Plus Loan:**

- **The last day to process GRAD Plus Loans will be two weeks prior to the end of the academic period. Student must be registered for at least 6 summer credits.**

**Private Loans:**

- Students enrolled less than half-time (less than 6 credits) **may not** qualify for **all** types of private loan options.
- Information regarding suggested alternative loan programs, and instructions on how to apply are available in the Student Finance Office. **BE SURE TO PRINT OUT YOUR PRIVATE LOAN APPLICATION AND SUBMIT IT TO THIS OFFICE. THIS OFFICE DOES NOT PROCESS PRIVATE LOANS ELECTRONICALLY.**
