Each recommender must return the form to you in a sealed envelope, which you then submit with your completed application, or the recommender may mail the recommendation directly to the **Office of Graduate Programs** at the above address.
4. Provide the **Transcript Request and Certification** form to your school. Your school may send a certified official transcript directly to the **Office of Graduate Programs** at the address above, or return it to you in a sealed envelope to be included with your completed application.
5. If English is not your native language, you must submit your official TOEFL test score. The University of Connecticut School of Law TOEFL code is **3915**.
6. If you apply through LSAC, the University of Connecticut School of Law's code is **3915**.
7. Please remember to provide your e-mail address below as we will communicate with you largely through electronic means.
8. Applications must be received by **June 1st** for the fall and **November 15th** for the spring semester. However, admission to this Program is competitive and it is to your advantage to apply as early as possible.
