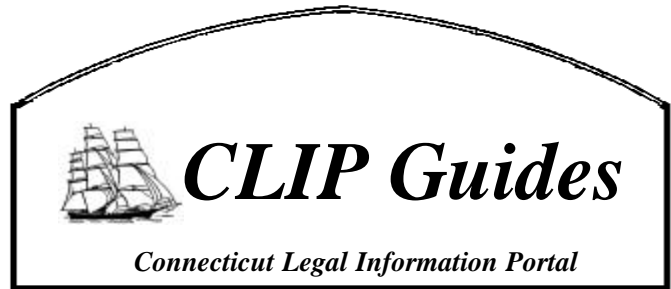

FOREIGN AND INTERNATIONAL INSURANCE LAW

The insurance law collection at the School of Law Library of the University of Connecticut aims to support the research and educational needs of students and faculty, and the needs of the Insurance Law Program. It also serves the legal information needs of the local, regional and national legal researchers, lawyers and the public at large.

Foreign and International Insurance law collection is growing rapidly at our library. To make sure you research is thorough and complete, please start with the library's online catalog (please check the "Insurance Law Collection" pathfinder to begin your research).

Primary Sources:

Code, Statute and Act (e.g. U.S. Code, Statutes of Canada, State Codes or Statutes, Insurance Companies Act 1982—England, Insurance Contract Law 5741-1981—Israel, etc.)

Regulation (e.g. Code of Federal Regulations, Federal Register, State Insurance Regulations, Insurance regulations of foreign countries, etc.)

State Insurance Bulletin & Notice

Attorney General Opinions

Cases (State and federal cases, Canadian Insurance Law Reporter, Canadian Cases on the Law of Insurance, Lloyd's Law Reports, UK)

European Union Law (Treaties, cases, legislation) (Check out on Lexis or Westlaw or InSource for statutes, codes, cases and foreign materials).

2. LEXIS & WESTLAW (password required)

Both LEXIS and WESTLAW have rich resources on the topic of Insurance. When you do the search using either LEXIS or WESTLAW, Make sure to check the International file, the News and periodical files. For general Insurance files on Lexis or Westlaw, please check “Insurance Law Collection” pathfinder.

WESTLAW Foreign and International Insurance Databases:

Under the topic of Insurance, choose either “Other Countries” or “Other U.S. Jurisdictions,” you can find Insurance Statutes, Bulletins and Administrative Code of Bermuda, Cayman Island, Puerto Rico, Guam and Virgin Islands. If you choose the topic “International and Other Countries’ Materials,” you will find not only international treaties, agreements and WTO or GATT decisions, but also legal information from several countries’, such as Mexico, United Kingdom, etc. “Financial Journal Index” (FJI) is a valuable file to use when you are looking for foreign insurance information.

3. Other Databases:

There are several hundred online databases on the Law Library Homepage. They allow you to search information on business, economics, finance, trade, etc.

To search the databases:

At the Law School Library Homepage, click on “Research Databases.” You can search the title of the databases, or browse by subject or by database title.
