

Each term, a select number of courses are scheduled so as to permit the distance learning students in the Insurance LL.M. program to participate remotely in the course. These courses are held at a scheduled day and time. Also offered could be asynchronous courses. These courses, while they may have a required, live first class meeting on campus, are completed online. Asynchronous (or “online”) courses are open to both J.D. and LL.M. students.

Before enrolling in any distance or online course, students are strongly urged to check the eligibility requirements for the state bar(s) in which with they intend to sit. Among the states with restrictions regarding these courses is New York and Massachusetts. The website maintained by the state’s Board of Law Examiners should be carefully reviewed.
